

2019 GENERATIONS IN JAZZ FESTIVAL CATERING FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What meals will be provided at Generations in Jazz?

The following meals are included:

- FRIDAY- Dinner
- SATURDAY- Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner
- SUNDAY- Breakfast, Morning Tea & Lunch

As part of the registration what is the value of the food component?

Regardless of the registration package selected the allocated breakdown for food is \$55.00 which is GST inclusive.

Where do I collect my meals?

NEW FOR 2019: Please complete the Preferred Meal Collection Time Form, available online, no later than **Monday 25th March 2019**. Once this information is received, we will advise of any changes required to your requested time slot, and the Catering Venue to which you will be allocated for meal collection. This applies to Friday Dinner, Saturday Dinner and Sunday Lunch.

This year there will be two collection points for Saturday Lunch; Schools A to P will collect from our new collection point located next to the AA Scott Warmup, and Schools R to Y will collect from the old collection point located directly behind the MGA warmup. Please note we have used the first letter of your School as per your registration. Please refer to your site map if you are unsure of these locations. For students with special dietary meals your meals will also be packed in the school allocation and labelled accordingly.

Breakfast will be provided at your accommodation venue prior to your arrival on Saturday and Sunday morning.

Do you cater for people with special dietary requirements?

Yes – there is an online form which needs to be completed by the school no later than Monday 25th March 2019. There is a tick box for those schools who do not have any special dietary needs - all students will be allocated a normal meal for the weekend.

We cater for-

Vegetarian, Gluten Free & Dairy Free as well as Vegan.

NEW FOR 2019: All participants who register as Special Dietary will receive an envelope as part of their registration, which will be posted to the school prior to the event. In each student's envelope will be the weekend's meal passes which must be presented to the catering staff in order to receive your meal. There will be one ticket per meal, except for Saturday Lunch as this meal will be labelled and packed with the other students. Special Diet dish up areas are located in the same food venue's as normal meals, so the school can stay together for meal times. Please ensure you have received these tickets prior to departure for Mount Gambier- no ticket, no meal.

All meals except breakfast, will be prepared by the Barn Palais and distributed onsite at the Generations in Jazz Festival Precinct.

Do any meals contain seafood?

No meals will contain seafood.

Please Note: Some independent food vendors may sell seafood onsite but purchasing from these sites is at the individual's discretion/risk.

Do you have nuts in any of the foods on the menu?

Our meals are nut free to the best of our knowledge; however, we cannot guarantee a cross contamination which may occur outside of our kitchen; for example bread rolls may come into contact with nuts in the bakery.

If you have students who suffer from a nut allergy, we ask that they complete the Nut Waiver form which can be downloaded from the Generations In Jazz website.

Are there facilities for people bringing their own food?

Yes, there are microwaves and a small fridge in the foyer area of the Barn Palais for students to use at meal times. Please ensure all food is clearly labelled with student name/ school.

If students opt to bring their own food, you must register their name and select 'Self Catering' on the online Dietary registration form.

Where else can I purchase food?

The festival venue is located outside of Mount Gambier however a small number of catering vans will be on site should you wish to purchase extra food. Mount Gambier also has a variety of fast-food outlets and cafes which will be open for extended trading hours throughout the Generations weekend.
